from nose or mouth.

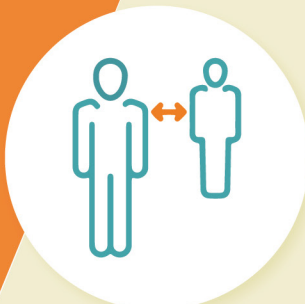


But do remember that you can remove
